MHA programs and services break down barriers to obtaining and maintaining a happy and healthy life and includes:

MHA Village

is a state model that integrates mental health, employment, housing support and education recovery services

MHA Antelope Valley Enrichment Services

collaborates with the community to create an integrated range of our recovery services

Homeless Assistance Programs

offer outreach and day services and work with our recovery programs on permanent solutions to homelessness

Transition Age Youth Programs

integrate housing, work, education, community life and wellness services for young adults

Operation Healthy Homecoming

serves low-income veterans and their families who are homeless and at risk of homelessness

Employment Services

provides work training, job search, placement and retention support

Wellness and Discovery Centers

are peer-run services that help individuals grow in their well-being

Homeless Innovations Project

uses mobile teams to integrate mental and physical health care for vulnerable individuals

Homeless Connections Initiative

is a partnership of service organizations, government, businesses, faith-based groups, colleges and other groups to work on community-wide solutions to long-term homelessness in downtown Long Beach
